Progress Report on Manganese Exploration in Rondônia, Brazil

Sola Resource Corp. (the “Company”) is progressing well with its exploration for manganese mineral deposits in the State of Rondônia, east of the Bolivian border, in Brazil.

During the past few weeks field crews have been pitting and sampling the Jaburi #1 manganese deposit with a view to estimating its areal extent, potential volume and grade variation. To date, twenty pits have been excavated, of which, sixteen have yielded fragmented massive manganese mineralization (manganite). The materials from these pits are being washed ready for shipment to an assay laboratory. The areal extent of the deposit has now been expanded to 7400 square metres and remains open in all lateral directions.

A reconnaissance team has recently been exploring the region around the Jaburi #1 manganese deposit and has discovered 3 new outcropping occurrences of massive manganese mineralization. The new occurrences are currently undergoing further investigation.
